Dear Mr. Monroe,

Pursuant to your July 23, 2007 letter requesting that the City of Kennesaw repeal the ordinance at issue, Section 66-2(4), we have recommended to our client that they do so expediently in light of the state's preemption statute, O.C.G.A. § 16-11-173(b)(1).

The Mayor and Council of the City of Kennesaw have agreed that the current version of this ordinance should be repealed and are planning to adopt a revised section 66-2(4).

As such, no legal action is necessary to cure this contradiction between the preempting state statute and this city ordinance, and we appreciate your bringing this discrepancy to our attention.
