The Honorable Supreme Court met pursuant to adjournment.

The following order was passed:

GEORGIACARRY.ORG, INC. et al. v. TOM CALDWELL et al.

From the Superior Court of Floyd County.

Appellants sought to carry firearms at a commercial airport during an air show held in October 2014 and, in September 2014, sought injunctive and other relief to be able to do so. On October 10, 2014, the trial court denied the request for interlocutory injunctive relief and, on April 13, 2015, dismissed the complaint as moot. The dismissal of the complaint fails to present an issue regarding the propriety of the grant or denial of equitable relief, and instead addresses the underlying legal issue regarding whether the claims were moot. Therefore, this Court lacks jurisdiction to consider the appeal, see Redfearn v. Huntcliff Homes Assn., 271 Ga. 745 (524 SE2d 464) (1999), and hereby directs that it be transferred to the Court of Appeals.
