The call of the following cases for oral argument will begin as scheduled. Please note that there will be a morning and an afternoon session unless otherwise indicated. Counsel are requested to check in with the Clerk upon their arrival in the courtroom before 10:00 a.m. or 2:00 p.m.

Cases are called in order as they appear on the calendar. Argument is limited to 20 minutes for each side except in direct appeals of judgments imposing the death penalty, which are limited to 30 minutes per side. Granted appeals from cases involving divorce and alimony and designated by an F in the case number are limited to 10 minutes per side.

Appellant opens the argument, appellee replies. Rebuttal is restricted to one attorney, representing appellant. Companion cases are argued as one case. The yellow light on the podium indicates 5 minutes remaining; the red light, that all time has expired. Counsel must abide by time limitations.

Only the following persons are authorized to sit inside the bar during oral argument: members of the bar of this Court; attorneys authorized to appear pro hac vice; pro se parties; third-year law students and law school graduates as set forth in Rule 91-103 of the Rules of this Court.
